

2005 DRAFT - MARIN COUNTY WIDE PLAN

The Marin County Wide Plan (Marin CWP) is updated approximately every ten years. The last Marin County Wide Plan was adopted in 1994. A new draft of the County Wide Plan was submitted for review in 2005 (the 2005 Draft). This 2005 Draft has not yet been adopted. It will be voted upon for approval and adoption by the County Supervisors in Fall 2007. Thus, we still have the opportunity to influence our county representation to make changes to the document.

The Tam Almonte Task Force members are extremely concerned about the proposed Commercial/ Mixed Use Land Use Categories, Section CD-8.7 of the 2005 Draft – Marin CWP. Please read the excerpt, explanation, and concerns regarding the Commercial / Mixed Use Land Use Categories as they relate to Almonte and Tam Valley. Then please read the letters sent to Marin County Representatives.

If you agree that the provisions of the proposed Commercial/ Mixed Use Land Use Categories, which encourage undesirable residential development in the Almonte and Tam Valley commercial areas, should be revoked, then please take the following six actions:
